**Weather and Practice/Event Cancellation:**

- Practices and events are sometimes canceled due to high winds, high seas, and heavy rain. We update rowers via email regarding weather conditions, but always call before practice if you have any questions regarding the weather.
- Because short-handed crews can be a safety issue, whenever possible please let us know in advance if you will be missing practice.
- Practices begin promptly at 3:30, with crews and boats determined by the rowers on site. Late arrivals hinder practice by necessitating reconfiguration of crews and boats – which takes valuable time away from on-the-water practice.
- Please make every effort to be on time to practice, or to let us know if you are running late so we can plan accordingly.

The museum staff will have weather updates by 2 pm daily.
