Early Families of Hull and Other Genealogical Connections

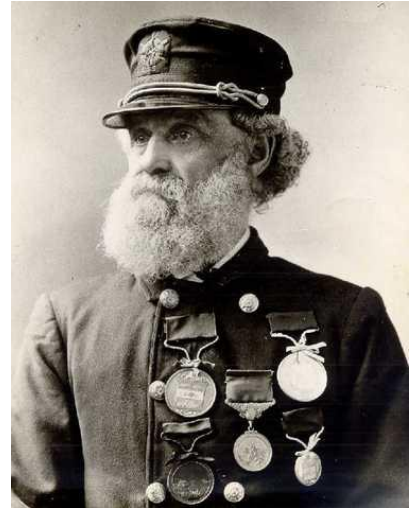
